Leesburg Air Service Center

Construction of the Leesburg Air Service Center (ASC) was completed in May 1943. The site was used as a satellite training facility of the Army Air Forces School of Applied Tactics based in Orlando, FL. Over the course of developing Leesburg ASC, the federal government acquired 2,232 acres of land by lease and condemnation between 1942 and 1945 for and Army Air Field (AAF) tent camp, rifle range, and ordnance area. The site consisted predominantly of vacant land; however, known site improvements included grading, fencing and 1,125 tents. The AAF determined that the property was excess to their needs on March 8, 1945, and declared it surplus. Between May 14, 1945 and April 10, 1946, the War Department terminated the leases and relinquished the property to the current owners.
